On-site services include a dedicated Health Services team consisting of RNs, LPNs, Health Associates and Certified Medication Aides, and Occupational and Physical therapy Associates, who implement any and all recommendations for physical and occupational therapy needs, Personal Consumer Advocates who plan recreational and community involvement activities, and a caring group of Direct Support Staff who teach and reinforce skills through individualized training programs and activities of daily living. In addition to our on-site staff, consulting services provide for psychological, occupational therapy and physical therapy, speech / language needs, and dietary needs.

Our homes are located in a small town where our individuals served are welcomed and treated as an integral part of the community. We offer personalized single or double bedrooms, a recreational room, therapy room, outdoor patios and gazebos and attractive living and dining areas. Individuals served are encouraged to participate in all activities of daily living, including self care, meal preparation, home living skills, social activities, and outings.
